CHÂTEAU SAINT BAULERY 2010 SAINT-CHINIAN

Château Saint Baulery is produced by the cooperative winery in Cébazan, which was founded in 1937 and offers a wealth of 30+ year old vines planted in prime terroir throughout the Saint-Chinian communes of Cruzy and Cébazan.

VINEYARDS

Nearly 750 acres throughout the communes of Cruzy and Cébazan, to the northwest of Béziers in the Saint-Chinian district.

APELLATION

AOC Saint-Chinian.

COMPOSITION

40% Carignan, 30% Syrah, 30% Grenache.

VITICULTURE

Produced from 30+ year old vines planted in clay/limestone-based terroirs. Yields of 3 tons/acre.

VINIFICATION

Traditional vinification, with no carbonic maceration. Unoaked, vinified entirely in stainless steel tanks.

ALCOHOL

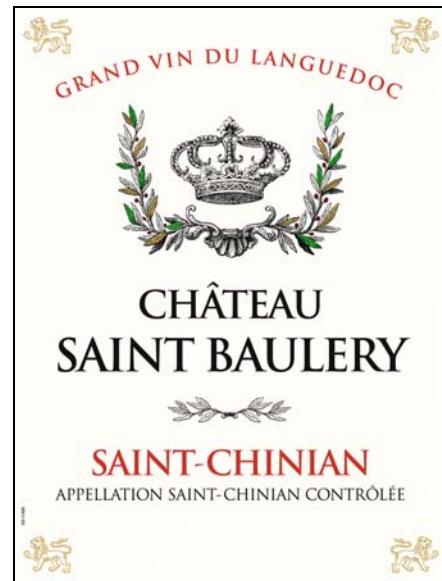
