

2km 2015 Altamira

pts. "The 2015 2K, from an estate in Altamira that measured two kilometers, is a fixed blend year after year--mostly Malbec and 35% Cabernet Franc from the stonier part of the estate.

In this vintage they purchased a couple of 500-liter French oak barrels to mature the wine, but the impact of the new oak in the wine is unnoticeable, perhaps because of the natural freshness of the year.

The nose is **clean and focused**, with a subtle mixture of **violets**, **wild berries and aromatic herbs**, quite elegant and nuanced. The palate is medium to full-bodied with **very juicy fruit**, a **velvety mouthfeel** and the tasty, chalky tannins linked to the limestone-rich soils. 2,700 bottles were filled in October 2016, days before I tasted it, yet the wine was **impeccable**"
