

# 2km

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2016 Paraje Altamira  
Malbec/Cabernet Franc

**92 pts.** *“Now that the range has grown, the name of the original wine has been extended from simply 2km to 2016 2km Malbec Cabernet Franc, a blend of 65% Malbec with 35% Cabernet Franc. The two grapes fermented together in concrete eggs. Part of the wine matured in 500-liter oak barrels and the rest in 225-liter barriques for some 14 months. The style, source and process have not changed since the initial 2013 vintage.*

There’s something **earthy, floral (violets) and notes of wild berries and herbs**. The palate reveals **the signature chalky tannins** from the limestone-rich soils from Altamira and **that special tastiness and mouthfeel**. 6,500 bottles were filled in August 2017.”
