



## TECHNICAL NOTES

### CAVE DES ONZE COMMUNES 2016 TRAMINER AROMATICO

*Founded in 1990, the Cave des Onze Communes includes 220 grower-members that farm nearly 150 acres across 11 municipalities in the Aosta Valley.*

#### VINEYARDS

Nearly 150 acres in the heart of the Alps, at the foot of the Mont Blanc, in the communes of Quart, Saint-Christophe, Aosta, Sarre, Saint Pierre, Villeneuve, Introd, Aymavilles, Jovençon, Gressan, Charvensod. Organic farming (non-certified). Vineyards are planted at 1800 to 2900+ ft above sea level, in gravelly, clay-based soils.

#### APPELLATION

Valée d'Aoste DOC.

#### COMPOSITION

Traminer Aromatico (Gewurztraminer).

#### VITICULTURE

Sourced from the communes of Villeneuve, Jovençon and Aymavilles. Vineyards are planted at 650 to 800 meters altitude. Manual harvest. Gravelly, clay soils.

#### VINIFICATION

The grapes are chilled down and undergo a light maceration prior to fermentation. Fermented and matured in stainless steel tanks. Bottled young. 3 to 5 g/ RS.

#### ALCOHOL

14%

#### TASTING NOTES

An aromatic wine with plenty of floral character (orange blossom, rosewater) over a backdrop of ripe, exotic fruit (lychee). Round, rich and well-balanced on the palate, with a long, finish.

#### SERVE WITH

Excellent with spicy Asian cuisine (especially aromatic Thai curries, or Salmon Korma).
