TECHNICAL NOTES

CHÂTEAU HAUT-MAURIN 2019 SAUVIGNON BLANC

Chateau Haut Maurin was purchased by the Sanfourche family in 1917, and is currently managed by Jean-Louis Sanfourche, fourth generation winegrower at the estate. Situated on the right bank of the Garonne, just 3 miles northeast of Cadillac, the estate is comprised of nearly 78 acres of vines in and around the village of Donzac.

VINEYARDS

Nearly 78 acres total, split between 21 acres of whites (47% Semillon, 41% Sauvignon Blanc, 12% Muscadelle) and nearly 57 acres red (74% Merlot, 17% Cabernet Sauvignon, 9% Cabernet France). Vines are planted in clay/limestone soils with gravelly outcrops on hillside sites.

APPELLATION

Bordeaux (Appellation Bordeaux Contrôlée).

COMPOSITION

100% Sauvignon Blanc.

VITICULTURE

From 6 to 25 year old vines yielding 3.5 tons/acre.

VINIFICATION

Vinified in traditional cement tanks (with temperature control).
Unoaked.

ALCOHOL

13.5%

TASTING NOTES

A classic Bordeaux Sauvignon Blanc, with zesty citrus character, aromas of white fruit/white flowers, fresh cut grass, and a characteristic mineral note.

Enjoy as an aperitif or with your favorite fish and shellfish.
