

BEL A CIAO 2021 ORANGE WINE

Olivier have a revolutionary approach to winemaking. It is the desire to break the rules that sets Bel A Ciao apart. Bel A Ciao is named after a revolutionary folk song of the same tune. The Cazenaves, Olivier and his wife, Anne Cazenave Mullins, own and cultivate biodynamic with methods their vineyard in Le Fleix, on the east bank of Garonne River, where it flows into the Dordogne. Bel A Ciao wine flows beautifully, with fresh lively complex characteristics.

VINEYARDS

From a 25 acre parcel in Le Fleix (Dordogne, on the border of the Gironde, about 5km northeast of St. Foy). Clay/limestone soils. Vines average 25 years in age.

100% Semillon.

VITICULTURE

Certified in Agriculture Biologique (AB – France). Yields of 3 tons/acre.

WINEMAKING

Macerated 3 weeks on the skins and fermented at 68°F in stainless steel tanks. Matured 6 months on the fine lees in concrete tanks.

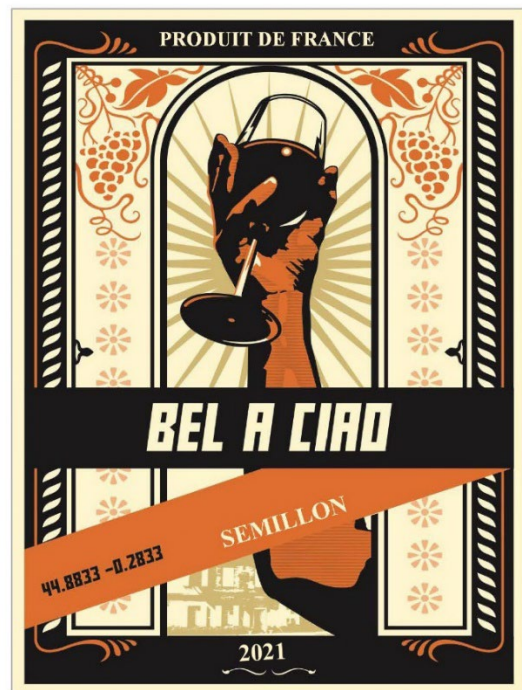

TASTING NOTES

Pure, complex aromas of tangerine peel and wildflowers on the nose. Round yet fresh on the palate, with spicy/savory notes. The finish is long and mouthwatering, with a pleasant touch of tannic grip and a light, saline character.

SERVE WITH

Excellent with lighter fare as an aperitif, it will stand up to a hearty Cobb salad and boldly flavored dishes such as moussaka and biryani. Also, an ideal pairing with grilled seafood or savory cheeses (feta, haloumi, more).
